

**ABATE of CA State Run      Golden State Rendezvous      September 11-13, 2015**

The ABATE State Run this year is being handled by Notorious Entertainment.

It is a bit different in how you can make your reservations ... there are NO Mail in's, and no Local Bonuses offered.

1 Campsite reservation is \$60.00 and includes two wristbands (Tent or Motorhome).

1 Entry is \$10.00 pre-paid online or \$15.00 at the "gate".

You can share your campsite with as many as will fit in your assigned space – as long as they paid the entry fee.

To Reserve a Campsite, you MUST go to this website

Then click on the word – Golden State Rendezvous

Then click on the word - Tickets

Then you pick Either JUST an ENTRY (No campsite) or click on Campsite and fill in the number of campsites you want Each campsite allows 2 individual wristbands –

EXAMPLE – click the number 1 for 1 campsite reservation and you and another person will have entry.

IF YOU want to add additional Wristbands or People you click on just Entry and fill in that number

THEN Click on the ADD to cart button.

IF you clicked Campsite - The system will automatically assign you a campsite number (at the moment it has the word "Seat" and that is the campsite number).

There will be an orange or red colored checkmark in that block that you are being assigned.

IF you do not want that space ... then you do this ...

**To select a different campsite than the one automatically assigned by the computer**, select the "Let Me Choose My Seats" button located below the seating chart. After you click this, available campsites are represented as white, selectable boxes with dark red borders, and unavailable campsites are represented by grey boxes. Deselect the campsite automatically assigned by the computer (it has an orange border) and select an available campsite of your choice.

Per the information given at the Southern Regional Rally – An Individual can purchase a single entry and then SHARE your campsite if you so choose and that will fit in your assigned space.
